

Directions to Metro's "Munger Property" in Scholls, off Scholls-Sherwood Road

From the North

1. Go west on Hwy. 26 from downtown Portland then take Hwy. 217 south to Tigard.
2. Heading south on Hwy. 217 from Hwy 26, take the Scholls Ferry Road Exit (Exit 4B, near Washington Square) and go west on Scholls Ferry Road (Hwy. 210).
3. Drive west on Scholls Ferry Road for 7.2 miles. You will drive through intersections with Murray, SW 175th, and Tile Flat roads.
4. At 7.2 miles from Hwy. 217 you will come to a flashing yellow light where Scholls Ferry Road turns south and a sign that says to go left to "Scholls." Turn left at the flashing light and follow Scholls Ferry Road south.
5. Drive south on Scholls Ferry Road past Groner School or your right and across the Tualatin River on a big, new bridge. Just before you get to Petrich General Store turn left onto Scholls-Sherwood Road and head east.
6. You will go 0.8 miles on Scholls-Sherwood Road, making a few right-angle turns. At .8 miles go straight onto a dirt road between farm fields instead of making the right turn on the paved road.
7. Drive down the dirt road (Munger Lane) until you have to turn, turn right, and drive toward the small house.
8. Just before you get to the house someone should meet you at the top of the road that goes down to the river. You can stop here to unload your bat and gear. After unloading, drive your car past the house and park in a clear open area, then walk back to the launch site. Do not drive down the hill from the house to the river.

From the South

1. From Hwy. 99W in Sherwood head northwest on SW Roy Rogers Road.
2. In just over 1 mile turn left onto Scholls-Sherwood Road heading toward Scholls.
3. Take Scholls-Sherwood Road west about 3.5 miles, making a few right-angle turns. When Scholls-Sherwood makes a left-hand turn at 3.5 miles, turn RIGHT onto the dirt Munger Lane.
4. Drive down the dirt road (Munger Lane) until you have to turn, turn right, and drive toward the small house.
5. Just before you get to the house someone should meet you at the top of the road that goes down to the river. You can stop here to unload your bat and gear. After unloading, drive your car past the house and park in a clear open area, then walk back to the launch site. Do not drive down the hill from the house to the river.
